

# ANN SMITH

1775 - 23<sup>rd</sup> Aug 1839

Born : BRECONSHIRE, WALES

Died : PROSPECT, NSW

Buried : CASTLEREAGH NSW



ANN SMITH was born in Wales about 1782. Ann was sentenced on 30 March 1802 at "Brown Greatlight" for 7 years to Australia as a Convict and arrived on 24 June 1804 on the ship "Experiment 1".

"Experiment" was built at Stockton in 1798, a ship of some 568 ton - the Master of the ship was Fran J. Withers. The ship sailed from Cowes on 2 January 1804 via Rio and took 174 days. 2 males and 136 females sailed, however 6 females died on the voyage.

Ann married Robert Bolton on the 3 November 1804.
